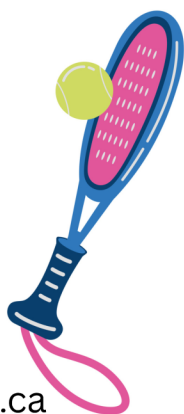

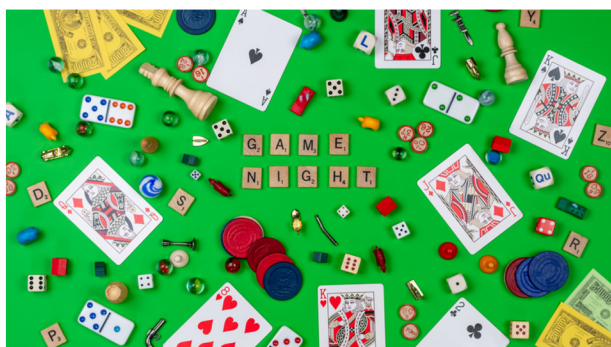

The History of Riverside Hall

and the Community Association.*

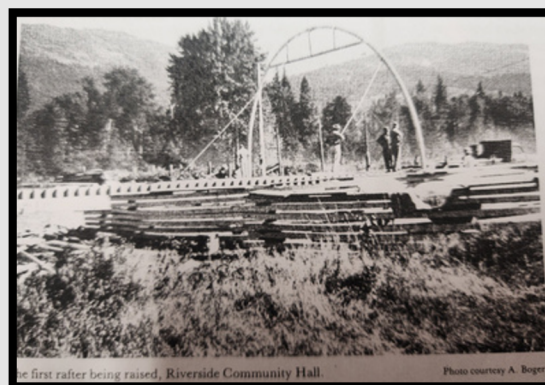
The Building of Riverside Hall

Four acres at a cost of \$50/acre were purchased from Pete Siemens to meet the needs of Ashton Creek and Trinity Valley folks, with the extra acreage in anticipation of future expansion. Plans were drawn by Ed Tipton and Harold Jewell and completed by Gerald Raboch. The design was based on the Salmon Arm Curling Club Quonset style building.

Fun Fact: *The arch ribs were constructed of four thicknesses of 1x4, glued and rib-nailed into an arch that were held in place by a boot and bolt system and anchored to outside cement wall foundation. The ribs were covered in with 2x8 tongue and groove.*

It took two years to complete the preliminary construction of the foundation and basement with hand mixers and wheelbarrows. The rest of the building construction started in 1958.

Equipment

- 9-inch springform pan

Ingredients

- ¾ cup butter, softened
- 1 ½ cups sugar
- 15 ounces whole milk ricotta cheese
- 3 large eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 large lemon, zested & juiced
- ½ tsp baking soda
- ½ tsp salt
- 1 ½ cups flour

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease a 9-inch springform pan with butter and powdered sugar; set aside.
2. In a large mixing bowl, cream together the butter and sugar until combined. Add in the ricotta cheese and blend until light and fluffy, about 4 to 5 minutes.
3. Mix in the eggs, one at a time. Add vanilla, lemon zest and lemon juice and mix to combine. In the same bowl, stir in the baking soda and salt. Lastly, add the flour and mix until just combined, scraping down the sides of the bowl to fully incorporate all the ingredients.
4. Pour the batter into the prepared springform pan. Bake 45-55 minutes, or until the cake is set and a toothpick inserted in the middle of the cake comes out clean.
5. Let cool in the pan for 15 minutes before removing the collar and base of the pan. Cool on a wire rack and dust with powdered sugar before serving. Also tastes good with whipped cream and/or raspberry coulis.

Notes This is a great make ahead recipe. Refrigerate in an airtight container for up to a week. Or you can store it in a domed pedestal on the counter at room temperature for three days.
